Crochet Pattern

Materials:

Green, Dark Brown, Light Tan Size 4 worsted weight yarn. (I used Caron one-pound: grass green, and off white, and red

hear oatmeal

4.0 mm hook

Black 10mm safety eyes

Fiber fill

Needle/Scissors

Pink Acrylic Paint/Small Brush

Black embroidery thread

Terms:

Back Loop Only - BLO Front Loop Only - FLO

Stitch - ST

Chain - CH

Single Crochet – SC

Half Double Crochet - HDC

Slip Stitch – SL ST

Single Crochet 2 stitches together - Sc2tog

(An invisible decrease stitch makes these look nice

and smooth)

Half Double Crochet Foundation Stitch - HDCFS Great Tutorial if this is

Between * * repeat this many additional times "x"

End of row (Parenthesis) total number of stitches in row

Magic Circle – MC



Big Note: I'm left handed; all pictures are shown with left handed progress unless otherwise stated. Pattern works for both left and right-handed crafters.

Another Note: be sure to use a stitch marker to mark the beginning stitch of each round to keep your place. It is very important to keep track of every round.



When working in rounds do not sl st at end of round or chain 1 unless stated.



Head: 4.0mm hook

With Green Color

1 – sc 6 in mc. Pull tight. (6)

2 - 2sc in each stitch around (12)

3 - *2 sc, sc* repeat 5x (18)

4 - *2 sc, sc, sc* repeat 5x (24)

5-7 – sc all the way around (24)

8 - *sc next 2, sc2tog* repeat 5x (18)

9 - *sc next, sc2tog* repeat 5x (12)

Place Safety Eyes between rows 5 and 6, 4 stitches apart. Stuff with Fiber fill

10 - *sc, sc, sc2tog* repeat 2x (9)

11 – Change Color to dark brown – 2 sc in each stitch all the way around. (18)

12-13 – sc in each stitch all the way around (18)

14 - *2sc, sc, sc* repeat 5x (24)

15-17 - sc all the way around (24)

18 - *sc next 2, sc2tog* repeat 5x (18)

19 - *sc next, sc2tog* repeat 5x (12)

20 - *sc2tog* repeat 5x (6)

Finish Stuffing. Leaving a long tail, cut and pull yarn through last stitch, thread with needle, push needle through front loops only of the 6 remaining stitches all the way around. Pull tight closing the bottom of body. Weave through securing closed.

Ears: make 2

With Green

1 - sc 6 in mc. Pull tight. (6)

2 - sc all the way around (6)

3 - *2sc, sc* repeat 2x (9)

4-5 – sc all the way around (9)

6 - *2sc, sc, sc* repeat 2x (12)

7 - *2sc, sc, sc, sc* repeat 2x (15)

8 - sc all the way around (15)

9 - *sc, sc, sc, sc2tog* repeat 2x (12)

10 - *sc, sc, sc2tog* repeat 2x (9)

Tie off, leave length for sewing to head. Pinch flat and sew to head. With a dry small brush lightly dab pink acrylic paint inside Alien's ears.

Feet:

With Green


1 - sc 6 in mc. Pull tight. (6)

2 - 2sc in each stitch around (12)

3 - sc, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc2tog, sl st, tie off Tie off leave length for sewing to front of body.







Neck Wrap:

With light tan hdcfs 25, ch 1, rotate 90 degrees and crochet down the side. Hdc in each stitch down (25) Tie of and slightly twist one end, wrap around neck of alien and sew ends together.

Hands: Make 2

With Green

1 - sc 6 in mc. Pull tight. (6)

2 - *2sc, sc* repeat 2x (9)

3 - sc all the way around (9)

4 – change color to light tan FLO *sc, sc, 2sc* repeat 2x (12) sl st in first sc in round. Tie off.

With the brown color in the BLO of row 3 sc in each st around (9)

5-8 – sc around (9) Stuff with fiber fill. Tie off and leave length for sewing to sides of body under the neck wrap.



With some green yarn on your needle sew a nose on the face.

With a little black embroidery thread on your needle sew eyebrows and a sideways smile on the alien's face.



The Baby Alien PDF Crochet Pattern is great for gifts and is an easy project for the intermediate crocheter.

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
